Dear other campus ministry,

I want to start by thanking you for following God's leading and showing His love to college students. I value the work you are doing to show students how better to follow the Lord.

In light of this, I want to offer your students the opportunity to attend a conference to sharpen their skills as evangelists and increase their dependence on God. I work with Campus Crusade for Christ, an interdenominational Christian organization that promotes evangelism and discipleship in more than 190 countries around the world. We host a conference in Indianapolis once a year that attracts more than 1,200 students, challenging them to deepen their faith and learn more about Jesus Christ. We want to be a resource for you.

IndyCC is a four-day retreat where students will listen to notable Christian speakers, including James MacDonald, pastor of the Harvest Bible Chapel in Chicago, and meet other students from Ohio, Illinois, Michigan and Indiana. One afternoon, students will take food boxes to the Indianapolis community to meet physical needs and start spiritual conversations that could lead to changed lives.

This year's conference, Wrecked into Redemption, will focus on the themes of brokenness, repentance and the Spirit-filled life. We want to challenge students to realize they are not perfect and they must rely on someone bigger – God. The conference will take place from Dec. 28 to Jan. 1 at the Indianapolis Convention Center. The \$200 fee covers hotel and conference costs.
